BIG EAST PLAYERS OF THE YEAR

Player of the Year

Heather Johnson, Notre Dame, 3B



Johnson led the BIG EAST in three major offensive categories in conference play this season. She led all hitters with a .967 slugging percentage. The senior blasted eight home runs, while recording 29 RBI. She also led the league in total bases with 59, while boasting an on-base percentage of .556. She batted .475 in conference play going 29-of-61 at the plate. Johnson became the first player in BIG EAST history to be named BIG EAST Player of the Week for three consecutive weeks, April 4-18.

Rookie of the Year

Kirsten Verdun, DePaul, LHP/1B



In the circle this season, the freshman recorded a 2.22 ERA, good enough for fifth in conference play. She posted a 12-0 record, while fanning 55 batters over 60.0 innings pitched. The rookie had an outstanding campaign in her debut for the Blue Demons, finishing first in BIG EAST games with a .571 on-base percentage. Verdun was second in the league in RBI with 27, batting .377 and slugging .811.

Pitcher of the Year

Jenna Cairra, Syracuse, RHP



Cairra led the BIG EAST in conference play in strikeouts with 115, including 38 looking. She also tallied the most wins in league play with 14, while just having four loses. The righty recorded a 1.81 ERA over 93.0 innings pitched. Opponents hit .213 against the junior in conference play. Overall this season, Cairra went 30-9 in the circle and earned three saves with a 1.47 ERA. She fanned 292 batters over 243.1 innings of work with 39 starts and 21 complete games.

Coaching Staff of the Year

Notre Dame, 19-1 BIG EAST/44-8 Overall

This is the sixth Coaching Staff of the Year honor for the Irish and first since 2004. Notre Dame (44-8, 19-1 BIG EAST) posted a .950 winning percentage in BIG EAST play and an .846 mark overall. The Irish captured their second consecutive BIG EAST regular-season title and 13th overall. Notre Dame ended the season on a 13-game winning streak. In BIG EAST play, the Irish led the league in batting (.385), slugging percentage (.636), on-base percentage (.459), runs scored (162), hits (204), RBI (145), doubles (39), total bases (337) and stolen bases (37).

BIG EAST NEWS & NOTES

Connecticut (19-30) 6-15 BIG EAST

- UConn closed out the 2011 campaign dropping a three-game series to then-No. 21/24 Notre Dame Mau 7-8.
- The Huskies lost a heartbreaker to the Irish in the final game of the series May 8. Notre Dame rallied in the seventh inning to edge UConn 14-11.
- Senior Julianne Towers finished her career with a .339 batting average in 199 career games. Towers' .339 average ranks sixth all-time at UConn. With her successful senior season, Towers ended her career ranked second in program history with 44 doubles, fourth with 106 RBI, second with 28 home runs and third with 351 total bases. This year, Towers tied the single-season record for home runs with 11. She was an All-BIG EAST First Team selection.
- The Huskies end the season with a 19-30 (.388) record and a 6-15 (.286) mark in BIG EAST play.

DePaul (41-15) 19-2 BIG EAST

- The Blue Demons reached the NCAA Columbia Regional Final in their fifth-straight NCAA appearance and 14th over the last 15 years.
- DePaul ended its season, dropping a 7-3 and a 8-0 decision to No. 4/8 Missouri in the regional final May 22.
- Overall, this is the 16th time DPU has qualified for the NCAA tournament and 10th time the Blue Demons advanced to the regional finals.
- The Blue Demons have reached the Women's College World Series four times (1999, 2000, 2005 and 2007).
- DePaul's 16-game winning streak was snapped May 7 in the series opener against USF. The Blue Demons dropped a 4-2 decision, but rebounded with a 13-5 win in six innings in the second game.

Georgetown (13-40) 6-12 BIG EAST

- Georgetown closed out its season with an 8-1 loss to Louisville on May 4, finishing in 10th place in the BIG EAST, the program's highest finish since joining the league three years ago.
- Against the Cardinals, junior Mackensy Carter pitched 5.1 innings, allowing only two earned runs and striking out three, while going 2-for-2 at the plate. She finished fourth in the conference in innings pitched with 176.1.

Louisville (38-20) 12-7 BIG EAST

- While serving as regional host, the Cardinals reached the regional final for the second-straight season in their eighth consecutive NCAA appearance.
- UofL dropped a 3-0 decision to No. 5/7 Califorma in the Louisville Regional Final May 22.
- Louisville picked up two wins at the BIG EAST Championship May 12-14, advancing to the championship final, where UofL lost 1-0 to No. 3 seed Syracuse for the second-straight year and picked up runner-up honors.
- Louisville put together a 12-game winning streak, spanning March 26-April 13, the fourth longest in school history. The 2006 teams holds the record with 17 games.

Notre Dame (46-11) 19-1 BIG EAST

- No. 19/24 Notre Dame wrapped up the 2011 campaign at the NCAA Ann Arbor Regional, just missing the regional final with a 9-8 loss to No. 2/2 Michigan May 21.
- This marked ND's 13th-straight NCAA Championship appearance and 16th overall.
- Notre Dame won its second-straight and 13th overall BIG EAST regular season title.
- In the BIG EAST Championship quarterfinals May 12, the Irish rallied in the sixth inning, putting up four runs to beat No. 8 seed Providence 6-4. No. 5 seed Louisville upset No. 1 seed ND in the semifinals May 13 with a 6-0 decision.
- The Irish put together a 14-game winning streak this season, spanning from April 17 to May 13 as Louisville bookended the streak.

Pittsburgh (34-17) 13-8 BIG EAST

- No. 6 seed Pittsburgh dropped a 2-1 decision to No. 3 seed Syracuse in the BIG EAST Championship quarterfinals May 12.
- Pitt was first on the board, putting up a run in the top of the third inning as senior Ashley Amistade bunted junior Jessica Rhodunda across the plate. The 1-0 Pitt lead held until the bottom of the seventh inning when Syracuse rallied off three hits for two runs.
- The 2011 campaign marks the first time in school history the Panthers have recorded three consecutive winning seasons under the same head coach.
- Pitt set several school records this season, including overall wins (34), BIG EAST wins (13), home runs (51) and shutouts (14).

Providence (23-30) 7-13 BIG EAST

- No. 8 seed Providence lost to No. 1 seed Notre Dame 6-4 in the quarterfinals of the BIG EAST Championship May 12.
- Senior Justine Stratton led the Friar offense, recording a pair of two-run homers. She has 10 home runs this season. Stratton is fifth in school history with 21 career round trippers.
- In 2011, the Friars set two program records. They set the single-season home run record with 58 and most walks in a season with 140. The previous home run record was 53, set in 2004 and the previous record for walks was 130, set in 2008.
- The Friars hit five grand slams this season, including two by sophomore Jessie Bryant.

Rutgers (19-30) 7-12 BIG EAST

- No. 7 seed Rutgers dropped a 5-2 decision to No. 2 seed DePaul in the quarterfinals of the BIG EAST Championship May 12.
- This was second-straight BIG EAST Championship appearance and fourth overall for the Scarlet Knights.
- The Scarlet Knights started the season with a .500 record through 14 games, marking the best start for RU since 2003.
- Starting on April 3 with a win at Connecticut, RU went on an eight-game winning streak, including six-straight conference victories. It marked the longest winning streak for the Scarlet Knights since 1996.
- Junior Brittney Lindley became RU's all-time career home run record holder, tallying 27 homers this season.

BIG EAST NEWS & NOTES

St. John's (20-30) 6-12 BIG EAST

- The Red Storm closed out the 2011 season with a 7-6 win over Marist May 7, snapping their seven-game losing streak.
- Sophomore Amber Curry finished the year with a team-high .357 batting average (46-of-129) and team-best 16 stolen bases to go with seven home runs, 32 RBI, seven doubles, one triple, 24 runs scored and 13 walks. Sophomore Chrissy Montez led the team with 41 RBI and 53 hits, while hitting .346 (53-of-153) and totaling six homers, eight doubles, one triple, 10 stolen bases and 12 walks.

Seton Hall (16-35) 3-19 BIG EAST

- Seton Hall posted a 1-3 record in its final week of play May 3-5, picking up a 4-0 win against Stony Brook.
- Head Coach Ray Vander May won his 400th career game with a 7-3 eight-inning victory at Georgetown on April 22.
- Senior Michelle Reed led the Pirates, batting .275 on 39 hits. She also recorded a team-best four triples and 18 stolen bases.

USF (33-21) 13-5 BIG EAST

- No. 4 seed USF lost to No. 5 seed Louisville 2-0 in the quarterfinals of the BIG EAST Championship May 12.
- The Bulls made their fifth appearance at the BIG EAST Championship, holding a 4-5 record in championship play. Their best tournament finish came in 2008, when they earned runner-up honors.
- Freshman pitcher Sara Nevins led the nation in saves with season with eight. She is second in the BIG EAST in opposing batting average (.197) and third in ERA (1.71) and strikeouts (193).
- USF put together a 10-game winning streak from March 20-April 10, including six wins over league opponents.

Syracuse (45-13) 15-5 BIG EAST

- The Orange picked up their first NCAA tournament win in their second NCAA Championship appearance with a 3-0 11-inning win over No. 22/20 LSU at the College Park Regional May 20, extending the SU winning streak to 15 games, the longest in program history.
- Syracuse wrapped up the 2011 season dropping a 13-5 decision to No. 17/18 Texas A&M and a 5-0 decision to LSU on the second day of NCAA regional action May 21.
- No. 3 seed Syracuse won the 2011 BIG EAST Championship, defeating No. 5 seed Louisville May 14 for the second-straight year. In the conference tournament final, SU hung on to edge UofL 1-0.
- Junior Jenna Caira was named the 2011 BIG EAST Pitcher of the Year and the BIG EAST Championship Most Outstanding Player for the second-straight year.

Villanova (16-32-1) 3-18 BIG EAST

- The Wildcats dropped a three-game set at Pittsburgh May 7-8 to close out the 2011 season.
- Junior Kristi Burlin led the Wildcats this season, batting .326, slugging .591, scoring 21 runs, batting in 31 runs, recording nine home runs and posting a .416 on-base percentage.
- Junior Caitlyn Delahaba led Villanova in the circle, fanning 142 batters and recording a 3.40 ERA over 167.0 innings of work.
